refunds for late arrivals or early departures. If notice of cancellation is received 60 or fewer days prior to arrival, part or all of amounts paid may be forfeited. All categories have automatic transmission, air conditioning, and radio. Skierized cars equipped with ski racks. Cars equipped with hand controls may be confirmed through advance notice only and are subject to additional restrictions and availability. Each daily rental is based on a 24-hour period beginning at the time you pick up the vehicle. Reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance. Not all car categories may be available at all locations.

Rental Requirements: Renter must be 25 years of age or older with a valid driver's license and a major credit card. Renters without a major credit card in their own name must meet cash rental requirements and must check with the car rental company in advance for approval. A major credit card is required to rent minivans, luxury, sports utility, and convertible cars. Renters are subject to having their driving records checked. Debit cards are not accepted as qualifications to rent; they may be used to pay for charges on return.

Rates Include: Unlimited mileage.

Rates Do Not Include: Taxes, other governmentally authorized or imposed surcharges, license and concession recoupment fees, airport fees, and optional items are extra. A per day fee for additional drivers of the vehicle will be imposed by Hertz. Optional items, such as gas and protection option, are also available at the rental counter for an additional charge.
