Please note:

- All luggage rules and fees are subject to change at anytime without notice.
- Standard luggage size allowance by carrier is 0-50 lbs and a maximum of 62 linear inches (length + width + height). Oversize luggage charges apply for luggage that exceeds these specified dimensions.
- If your flight is a codeshare flight (operated by a partner airline), the luggage policies will be dictated by the airline operating your flight.
- Sporting equipment such as skis or golf clubs is considered a checked bag, subject to excess luggage fees, and must meet size and weight requirements.
- Some exceptions to luggage fees apply to specific customers who may be a member of a specific airline rewards program or for customers purchasing a premium or first-class or business class ticket.
